## Tool List:

### Make a Carved Oak Box with Peter Follansbee

The following list is suggested tools only. If you have them- great, bring them along- if not- don't worry about it. The school has plenty of tools and Peter will be bringing some that you can use also:

Planes - smooth, block, rabbet (optional), longer plane if you have it - SHARP.

Chisels - something narrow for the till trenches - I use 5/16"; wide paring chisel, maybe 1"-1 1/2"

Boring tools, for pilot holes for wooden pins and for iron nails. I use an eggbeater drill with very narrow bit for the nails. 1/4" or 5/16" for the wooden pegs.

Something that'll do 3/8" hole for till lid

Backsaw.

Crosscut saw

Square, awl, ruler, marking gauge

Hammer

Mallet

Compass

CARVING TOOLS; bring what you can. Below are some I use a lot, but don't run out and buy them all. We can form designs according to what you have. I'll have some extras, but bring what you have and we'll go from there. These sizes and "sweeps" are according to the Swiss-made tools:

V-tool - #15, 12mm

Gouges - ,

#7 18mm (about 3/4")

#5- 12mm (about 1/2")

Smaller #7 - maybe half the size of above

#8 - 18mm

Narrow #8, 8mm
