The following tool list is by no means exhaustive. If you have a favorite layout tool, bring it. Don't feel you have to purchase every tool on this list. Usually there are enough that we can share.

Shoulder plane (large)

Electric jigsaw (very important for joinery) (the school does have 3)

Chisels and mallet

Wood Owl 3/4" and 1-1/4" nailchipper bits from Traditional Woodworker (<http://www.traditionalwoodworker.com>)

Corded drill with a 1/2" chuck

5/8" auger bit for drawboring

Jack plane or jointer plane

Layout tools: combination square, framing square, pencils, tape measure

Ibuprofen (you think I'm kidding....)

Glue scraper
