Sharp pencils

Note: The school has many of the tools required but it is always better to get the “feel” of working with your own tools.

The school will have a few of the “optional” carving gouges but you will need the others. They will be available at the Manchester Woodcraft store– ask for the 10% student discount. These tools can also be purchased at a considerable savings from

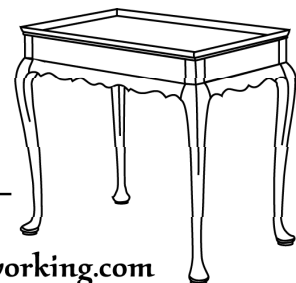
